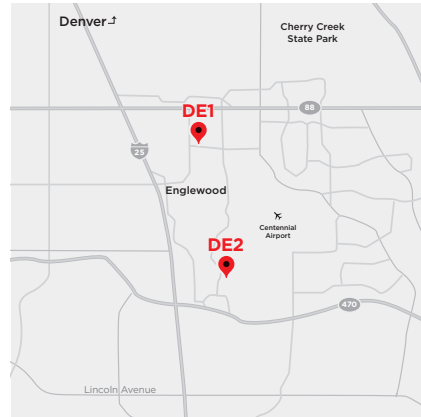

Our two Denver International Business Exchange™ (IBX®) data centers deliver 81,000 square feet (7,600+ square meters) of colocation space, enabling our customers to thrive at the digital edge. Customers have access to low-latency routes to the Chicago and San Francisco metro regions, as well as to the Equinix global interconnection platform that extends across 52 markets.

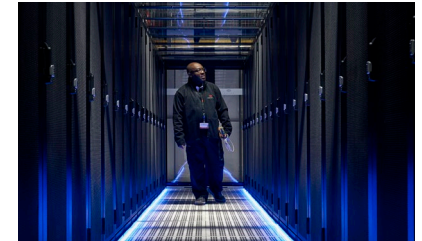

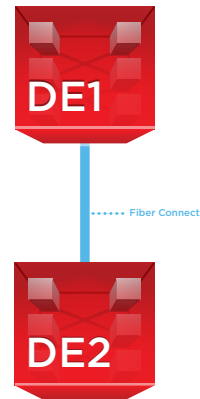
